A polite reminder to all hall users: Our Village is **20mph** throughout.

We are still receiving complaints of cars speeding down Church Street heading to the village hall. We have very few pavements and a mixed population of elderly, and young people, dog walkers, and cats. Please be mindful of your speed in our village, be aware of our community and pass the message on to all who attend your groups/classes.

New Buckenham has its own Community Speedwatch group and they regularly monitor the speed within the village. The village hall committee is working with the Parish Council and the Speedwatch group to encourage slower, safer driving.

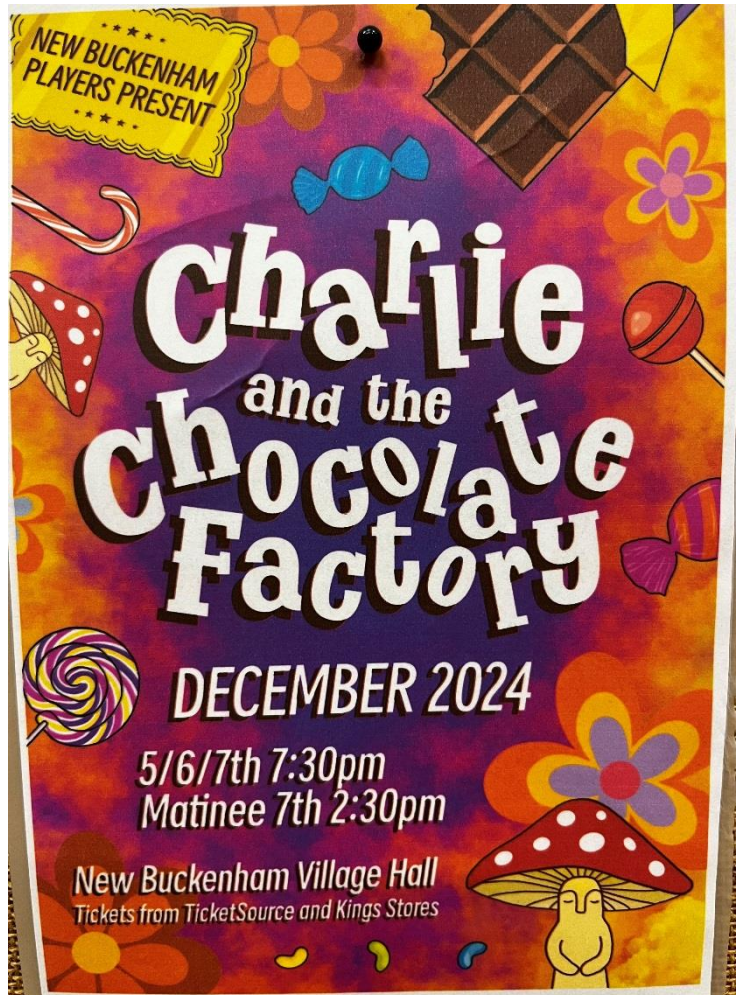

YOUR HIRE

Please remember that the hall is a multipurpose facility used by many people each week. We have a wonderful group of trustees and two excellent cleaners who ensure the hall is ready for hire, however we do not have the finances or time to clean before and after every hire. Please don't forget that it is your responsibility to clean up after your booking, as stated in your hire agreement. If your group use the kitchen please ensure this is cleaned after use and all crockery and cutlery returned. Tables should be cleaned after use, and a gentle reminder please to ensure any furniture you use is returned safely. There are photos on the kitchen notice board showing correct storage of tables. These should be side on in the trolley, and face to face, legs to legs to prevent damage. Chairs should be stacked in 10s, but please also leave a few stacks of 5. Ensure these are stacked straight to prevent them tipping over.
